MICRO CORING

Members are reminded that micro coring of the greens will commence on Monday 29 June. This work should take approximately 3 days depending on weather conditions and involves very fine cores being taken out of the greens and then having the greens top dressed and seeded.

During this period the course will not be open for play until:

Monday 29 June 2009	9.00 am
Tuesday 30 June 2009	8.30 am
Wednesday 01 July 2009	8.30 am

Members must observe these time scales and “cutting in” or “starting from” the fourth tee is not an option.

This work is being carried out at this time of year in order to cause minimum disruption rather than carrying out full coring in March and September as has happened in previous years. This work was successfully tested last year at the same time and on this basis and again dependant on weather conditions the greens should be back to normal within a very short period of time.

The principal behind coring at this time of year is that the cores recover much quicker than in the Spring or Autumn because the grass is growing much faster.

This is part of an ongoing project to enable Dunbar Golf Club to raise the standard of its greens to being the best in the area and I would ask for you as members to be patient and understanding during this short period of minor disruption.
